- FORMAT:** Once again, we're bringing back the 900 round. The 900 Round is perfect for newer shooters who may not be able to get the longer distances, or who simply don't have the courage or time invested in shooting them... and yet, the cream will rise to the top. For those of you who are unfamiliar with the 900 round, archers (male and female) shoot 60, 50, and 40 meters at the 144 cm face. 30 arrows are shot at each distance in 6 arrow ends (the timing is just like a FITA).
- DIVISIONS:**
- Collegiate -** Men and Women: Recurve, Compound  
**Guests -** Space permitting.
- Adult Compound, Adult Recurve (men and women duke it out)
  - JOAD Compound, JOAD Recurve (11 to 18 at the time of the tournament, boys and girls combined – no separate JOAD distances or classifications).
  - Special JOAD: If space allows (and this will be a last minute decision), we will allow JOADs ages 10 and under to shoot special short distances at no charge (though donations to cover target costs will be accepted).
- Optional "Open" OR round -** Two categories – Compound and Recurve. No gender divisions. No age divisions. We will register the OR with the NAA for qualifying purposes.
- AWARDS:** Awards will be given for 1<sup>st</sup>- 5<sup>th</sup> place in the collegiate divisions. This year we will give an AZ Collegiate Team award which will be calculated by combining the top four division scores from each team (one each from Male Compound, Female Compound, Male Recurve, Female Recurve).
- There will be NO awards for Adults or JOADs... or the OR.

- RULES:** USA Archery rules apply. Competitors must be College Archery Program (CAP) eligible.
