

# ARIZONA CUP 2007

## Information and Registration Forms

### April 11 - 15, 2007

- Tournament Location:** Phoenix, Arizona, USA, Ben Avery Shooting Facility
- Host:** Arizona State Archery Association, member of the National Archery Association (USA Archery)
- Format:** **World Ranking Tournament**, FITA round, Team Rounds and Elimination Round -The Tournament is open to all Recurve and Compound Competitors. *This tournament is one of the United States Archery Team qualifying tournaments.* See the NAA's USAT [criteria](#).
- Rules:** NAA and FITA rules, including dress codes. All archers must wear appropriate footwear. This means shoes or sandals appropriate for a desert setting.
- Drug Testing:** Any archer may be subject to unannounced drug testing. Refusal to test may lead to disqualification. Request information from USADA in advance of tournament, if you have questions. [USADA website](#)
- Category:** Men Recurve and Compound (shooting 90, 70, 50 and 30 meters)  
Women Recurve and Compound (shooting 70, 60, 50 and 30 meters)  
At 30m, all competitors will shoot on a 6 ring, multi-face setup.  
No other official categories are offered.  
(Archers that are also eligible as Collegiate, Junior and Paralympian will officially compete in the above categories, however these categories will also be sorted and listed for recognition purposes only.)
- Entry Fee:** \$100.00 payable in US funds (includes \$80 tournament fee and \$20 Ben Avery Facility range fee)  
Late Fee: add \$35.00 US.
- Deadline:** Postmarked March 19, 2007 – Space is limited to the field capacity so register early. Registrations postmarked after March 19 will be assessed a late fee. Late entries will be accepted until postmarked April 1, as space permits. There is no on site registration.
- Cancellations:** up to March 28 will receive a full refund. A \$35 fee will be withheld after March 28. Email notification of cancellation is acceptable. No refunds after April 4, 2007 (one week prior to tournament)
- Waiver:** All archers must sign a liability waiver prior to participating in tournament activities. Archers under 18 years of age must also have a parent or guardian sign the waiver.
- Official Hotel:** Crowne Plaza Metro Center, details posted at [www.arizonacup.com](http://www.arizonacup.com). Room Block pricing ends March 19, 2007. There are limited number of rooms at the special pricing.
- Traffic:** Expected to be heavy on I-17 - Allow extra drive time
- Open Teams:** **Arizona Cup Open Team Round** is included in the registration. Deadline to register an open team is 10:30am on Friday, April 13<sup>th</sup>. See rules on page 4.
- National Teams:** **Official National Team competition will be held on Sunday, April 15. Only those archers designated by their nation in the Team Meeting may compete. Only those categories with two or more teams will be contested. National Teams need to be registered by the country in advance. See [FITA Member Invitation](#).**
- Awards:** Awards will be given to the top three archers in the four official categories for the Qualification Round and the Elimination Round. Arizona Cup Champion is the winner of the Elimination Rounds.
- Food on Site:** Food concession information will be on [www.arizonacup.com](http://www.arizonacup.com), when it becomes available.
- Shade and Seating:** Shade canopies will be provided for the archers. Spectators may erect their own shade canopies behind the designated line. Seating will be provided for the archers. Spectators will need to bring their own seating. All spectator tents must be securely staked down.
- Airport:** Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport (PHX) - 33 miles from tournament venue.

Our intent is that as many archers as possible will enter the Elimination Round. Byes will be granted as necessary. If a category has more than 64 archers, then there may be a cut to 64 archers, to be determined.

#### **Open Team Rules:**

1. An open team may consist of any three (3) registered archers at the Arizona Cup in the same category. No mixed teams.
2. Team names must be dignified and subject to the acceptance by the Team Round Coordinator.
3. All Teams should be in uniform of matching shirts. Strongly encouraged, but not required.
4. All archers must wear appropriate footwear. This means shoes or sandals appropriate for a desert setting.
5. Teams will be seeded based on the team's combined FITA scores.
6. Team Leader will fill out the Open Team Scorecard with archer names and final FITA scores and turn in to the Team Round Coordinator.
7. Only one registration form per team needs to be returned.
8. Deadline for Team Registration is 10:30am, Friday, April 13<sup>th</sup>. Pre-Registration is appreciated although we will keep a sign-up list at the Registration tent.
9. Team Registration forms may be received independently from individual's registration form.

11. In the event there are not two or more teams entered in a category, then that category will not be contested.
12. The open team rounds are open to all and a small cash prize will be awarded to the gold, silver and bronze teams in lieu of trophies.
