### Format:

Qualification: 2 x 70m Round, (total 144 arrows @ 70 meters), Team Rounds and Elimination Round -The Tournament is open to all Recurve and Compound Competitors. *This tournament is one of the United States Archery Team qualifying tournaments.* See the NAA's USAT criteria.

Archers will be re-ranked after the first 70m Qualification Round.

Ranking for the Elimination and Team Rounds will be based on the total of the Qualification 70m Rounds.

#### Rules:

NAA and FITA rules, including dress codes. All archers must wear appropriate footwear including closed toe shoes as the tournament takes place in the desert.

# Membership:

NAA, NFAA or a foreign IOC National Governing Body for archery. To be eligible for USAT points, you must be a NAA member. We encourage membership in both NAA and NFAA. NAA membership website and NFAA membership website

## Category:

Men Recurve and Men Compound (shooting 70 meters) Women Recurve and Women Compound (shooting 70 meters)

No other official categories are offered. (Archers who are also eligible as Collegiate, Junior and Paralympian will officially compete in the official categories; however these sub-categories will also be sorted and listed for recognition purposes only.)

#### **Drug Testing:**

Any archer may be subject to unannounced drug testing. Refusal to test may lead to disqualification. Request information from USADA in advance of tournament, if you have questions. USADA website

Room Block pricing ends March 21, 2008. There are a limited number of rooms at the special pricing.

## **Entry Fee:**

\$120.00 payable in US dollars

(includes \$100 tournament fee and \$20 Ben Avery Facility range fee) Late Fee: add \$35.00 US.

#### Deadline:

Postmarked March 21, 2008 – Space is limited to the field capacity so register early. Registrations postmarked after March 21 will be assessed a late fee. Late entries will be accepted in order received as field capacity permits. There is no on site registration.

### **Cancellations:**

Up to March 26 will receive a full refund. A \$35 fee will be withheld after March 26. Email notification of cancellation is acceptable. No refunds after April 2, 2008 (one week prior to tournament)

#### Waiver:

All archers must sign a liability waiver prior to participating in tournament activities. Archers under 18 years of age must also have a parent or guardian sign the waiver. See Page 5.

### **National Teams:**

Official National Team competition will be held on Sunday, April 13. Only those archers designated by their nation in the Team Meeting may compete. Only those categories with two or more teams will be contested. National Teams need to be registered by the country in advance. See separate FITA Member Invitation for additional information and registration forms for national teams and officials.

# **Open Teams:**

Arizona Cup Open Team Round is included in the registration. Deadline to register an open team is 10:45am on Friday, April 11<sup>th</sup>. Open Team Competition will be held on Friday afternoon, April 11. See Page 4

## Awards:

Awards will be given to the top three archers in the four official categories for the Qualification Round and the Elimination Round. Arizona Cup Champions are the winners of the Elimination Rounds.

## Shade and Seating:

Shade canopies and seating will be provided for the archers. Spectators may erect their own shade canopies behind the designated line. Spectators will need to bring their own seating. All spectator tents must be securely staked down.

## Airport:

Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport (PHX) - 33 miles from tournament venue.

<u>Coaches:</u> Personal coaches are not allowed in the archer's area during scoring. Personal coaches must stay behind the spectator line during scoring. Personal coaches are allowed forward to the waiting line during practice. Credentialed National Coaches are allowed up to the waiting line during scoring and may sit in the archer's tents.

**Agents:** Approved persons assisting AR archers or the Tournament officials may sit in the archer's tents. These persons will be assigned identification credentials.

# **Open Team Rules:**

- 1. An open team may consist of any three (3) registered archers at the Arizona Cup in the same category. No mixed teams.
- 2. Team names must be dignified and subject to the acceptance by the Team Round Coordinator.
- 3. All Teams should be in uniform of matching shirts. Strongly encouraged, but not required.
- 4. All archers must wear appropriate footwear. This means closed toe shoes appropriate for a desert setting.
- 5. Deadline for Team Sign-up is 10:45am, Friday, April 11<sup>th</sup>. Pre-Registration is appreciated although we will keep a sign-up list at the Registration tent.
- 6. Teams will be seeded based on the team's combined Final Qualification scores.
- 7. Open Team Leader will fill out the Open Team Scorecard with archer names and final Qualification scores and turn in to the Team Round Coordinator for ranking and target assignment.
- 8. Only one registration form per open team needs to be returned.
- 9. Open Team Registration forms may be received independently from individual's registration form.

- 11. In the event there are not two or more teams entered in a category, then that category will not be contested.
- 12. The open team rounds are open to all, including National Teams, and a small cash prize will be awarded to the gold, silver and bronze teams in lieu of trophies.
