Location: Papago Park Archery Range, Phoenix, AZ.

Who: All Archers welcome. You must be a NAA/Arizona resident to make the Duel Team. The AZ Duel team is made up of 20 seniors (6 recurve men, 6 recurve women, 4 compound men, 4 compound women) and 4 juniors (Jr recurve male, Jr recurve female, Jr compound male and Jr compound female). Arizona juniors often make the senior Arizona team. AZ Team members receive support from the ASAA. Often support includes a team shirt and Duel tournament entry fee paid for. Duel Team members must be able to attend the Duel in California on October 31 & November 1, 2009. See www.calarchery.com.

Format: Two day FITA (36 arrows at four distances = 144 arrows) Long distances on the first day. Short distances on the second day.

Rules: NAA and FITA rules apply. **NAA Dress Code will be enforced.** At 30 meter distance, all senior, Junior, Cadet and Master divisions must shoot on a 6 ring multi-face set-up, unless **ALL** archers on that target agree to use a single 10 ring.

Awards: The Duel Team will have their California Duel registration paid and will receive a Team Shirt. JOADs will receive an award. Sorry, no other awards given.

You may also mail in your registration (check or cash). Deadline for mail-in registration is September 28 (postmarked). All late registration is subject to a \$10.00 late fee and will be accepted if space is available.

Liability Waiver

(All participants must sign. Parents of minors must sign for youth.)

IN CONSIDERATION of being allowed to participate in a Papago FITA Archers event (whether hosted by the Papago FITA Archers or another group or individual at any location) including archery practices, instruction, and/or tournaments (collectively referred to as "Activities") I acknowledge and agree that:

1. I understand dangers may be caused by my own actions, or inaction's, as well as the actions or inaction's of others participating in the Activities. I understand the nature of the Activities and acknowledge my experience and capabilities and believe I am qualified to participate in such Activities. I further acknowledge that I am aware that the Activities will be conducted in facilities open to the public. I further agree and warrant that if, at any time, I believe conditions to be unsafe, I will immediately discontinue further participation in the Activities.
2. I FULLY UNDERSTAND that:
 - (a) the Activities involve risks and dangers of **SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING PERMANENT DISABILITY, PARALYSIS AND DEATH (Risks);**
 - (b) these Risks in which the Activities take place or **THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED BELOW;**
 - (c) there may be other risks and social and economic losses either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and

I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES, COSTS, AND DAMAGES incurred as a result of my participation in the Activities.

3. I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, **HEREBY RELEASE, DISCHARGE, COVENANT NOT TO SUE, AND AGREE TO HOLD HARMLESS** the National Archery Association of the US (NAA), the Arizona State Archery Association, the City of Phoenix, The State of Arizona, the Papago Sports Complex, The Papago FITA Archers, the National Alliance for the Development of Archery, their respective administrators, directors, agents, officers, volunteers, and employees, other participants, any sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the Activities take place (each considered one of the Releasees herein) from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages on account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations and further agree that if, despite this release, I, or anyone on my behalf makes a claim against any of the Releasees named above, **I WILL INDEMNIFY, SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS EACH OF THE RELEASEES FROM ANY LITIGATION EXPENSES, ATTORNEY FEES, LOSS LIABILITY, DAMAGE OR COST ANY MAY INCUR AS THE RESULT OF ANY SUCH CLAIM.**

I hereby grant Papago FITA Archers, its assigns, sponsoring organizations, affiliates, and/or agents permission (at no cost) to take, use, reproduce, publish, and distribute photographs, video, and audio of me and/or photographs, video, and audio in which I may be involved with others for the purpose of promoting the Papago FITA Archers Club and Activities;
5. **FOR PARTIPANTS OF MINORITY AGE (UNDER 18);** This is to certify that, as a parent or guardian for this participant, I do consent not only to his/her release, but also for myself/ourselves, and my/our heirs, assigns and next of kin, to release and indemnify the Releasees from any and all liability incident to my/our minor child's involvement as stated above.

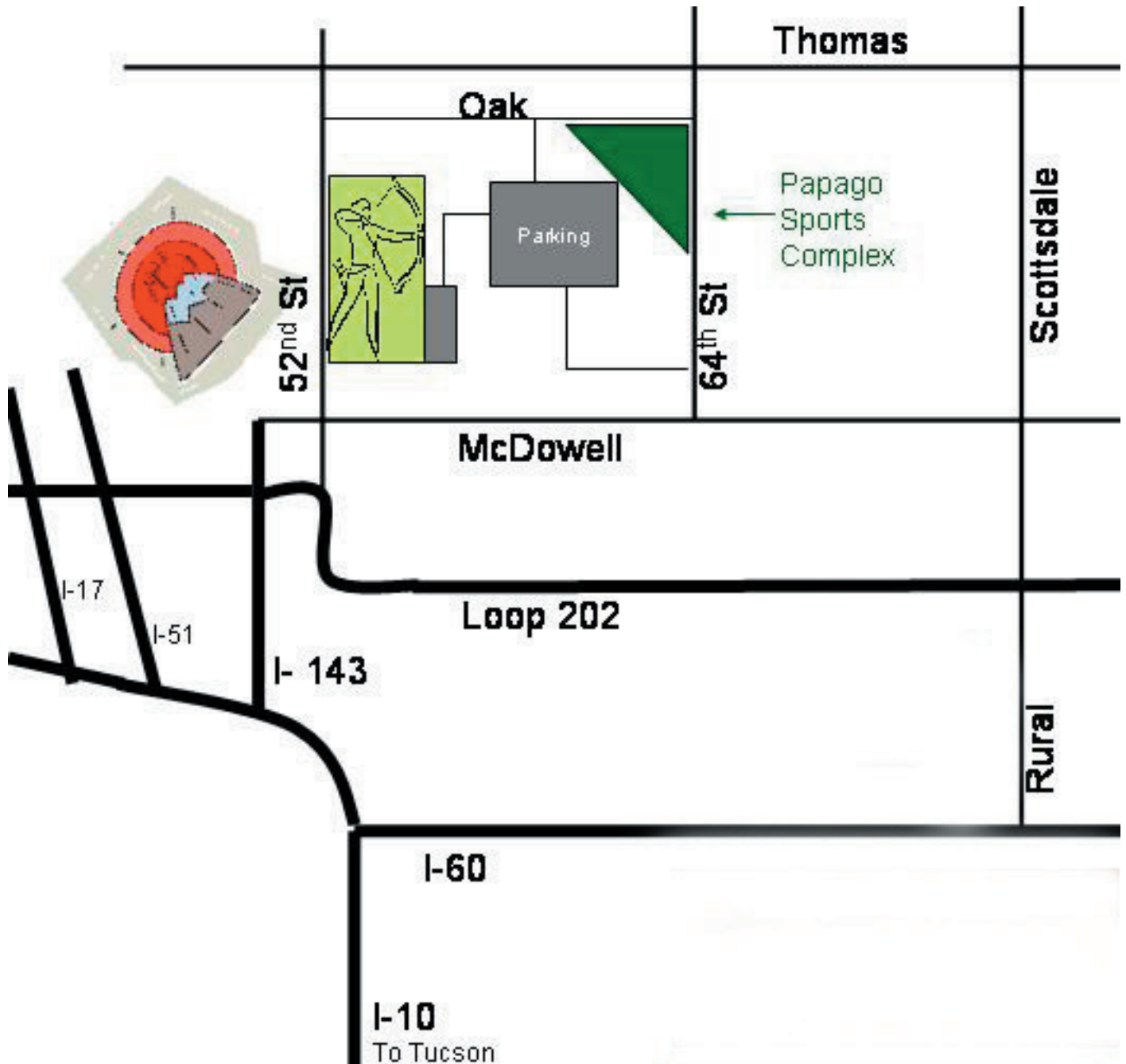
