#### **Optional Transportation:**

April 7 – 13, 2009 optional tournament transportation for National Teams is being provided compliments of AAE Cavalier USA. Transportation is limited to group transportation to/from airport, Crowne Plaza Hotel and tournament venue. Transportation capacity is limited and available on a first come first served basis upon receipt of tournament registration <u>and</u> registration payment. After the deadline, any remaining spaces may be made available to individual archers.

Private Ground Transportation is also available by Rental Car, Taxi or Shuttle, available for your private arrangement at the airport and hotel for an additional fee.

Please reserve your transportation in advance.

#### Payments:

All payments shall be in US dollars.

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### VISA and other travel permissions:

A VISA is required to enter the United States, unless you are from a country participating in the VISA Waiver Program (VWP). A machine readable passport is required as part of the VWP. Please apply for your VISA well in advance as it may take several weeks for processing. Visit www.state.gov for additional information about traveling to the USA.

# Regulations:

USA Archery and FITA rules including dress codes. Sport shoes covering the entire foot are required. You may enter an unlimited number of archers in the Qualification and Individual Elimination Rounds. You must designate your three archer team per category for your National Team at the Team Meeting on April 8, 2009.

We also offer a separate Open Team competition for those that want the team shooting experience. The Open Team rounds are open to all including the National Teams.

Men Recurve and Men Compound

Women Recurve and Women Compound

(Team Competition: only those categories with two or more National teams entered will be contested. Please note that a minimum of three teams from different countries in a category is required to qualify for a World Record.)

All competitors and officials must sign a Waiver and Release of Liability and Assumption of Risk form. See last page. National Team members may sign the waiver at the field at Check-In.

Awards will be given to the top three archers in the Qualification Rounds and in the Elimination Rounds.

The Arizona Cup Champion is determined by the winner of the Elimination Round.

Awards will be given to the top three teams in the National Team Elimination Round. Small cash prizes will be given to the Open Team winners in lieu of trophies.

I further acknowledge that I am aware that the activity will be conducted in facilities open to the public during the Activity. I further agree and warrant that if, at any time, I believe conditions to be unsafe, I will immediately discontinue further participation in the Activity.
- 2. I FULLY UNDERSTAND that:
  - (a) The National Archery Association of the US activities involve risks and dangers of SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING PERMANENT DISABILITY, PARALYSIS AND DEATH ("Risks");
  - (b) These Risks in which the Activity takes place or THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED BELOW;
