**ALL MAILED REGISTRATIONS NEED TO ARRIVE BY MARCH 27 TO AVOID LATE FEE**

Late registration is subject to LATE FEE on a space available basis using existing target set-up and a shooting assignment cannot be guaranteed.

**LOCATION:** Ben Avery Shooting Facility, FITA Range, Phoenix, Arizona

**TOURNAMENT RULES:** USA ARCHERY and new April 1, 2010 FITA rules including USAA [dress code](#) will be enforced.

**CHAMPIONSHIP ELIGIBILITY:** USA Archery membership listing Arizona as your residence is required for you to compete for State Championship titles and awards. Guests (Non-USAA or Non-Arizonans) are welcome to shoot in the Qualification Round and Elimination Round. New State Records for a 72 arrow round are to be established.

**CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS:** Awards will be distributed for the Arizona State Outdoor Championship based on the number of actual participants in the category and mailed out after the tournament using the following awards structure:

- **Up to 2 participants: 1<sup>st</sup> place only**
- **3 - 4 participants: 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place only**
- **5 or more: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places**
- **JOAD categories: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> places**

**QUALIFICATION ROUND:** 72 arrow Qualification Round will determine the State Champions

- All Seniors and Juniors will shoot qualification at 70 meters -122cm face (and will shoot 70m for the elimination matches)
- All Masters and Cadets will shoot qualification at 60 meters -122cm face (but will shoot 70m for the elimination matches)
- All Cubs will shoot at 50 meters -122cm face
- All Bowmen will shoot at 30 meters -122cm face
- Championship eligible archers will shoot in separate Championship Categories
- Guests are welcome.
- All competitors may enter the "Get Set" Open using their qualification score for ranking.
- Qualification will be shot with one AB line.

**ELIMINATION ROUND:** Included in your registration fee is the additional Elimination round. **All competitors are welcome to participate and Get Ready for the new Set System, that we cleverly called the "Get Set" Open.**

**"GET SET" OPEN: New Set System Elimination Round Format:**

- **70m Recurve** (All Recurve and Barebow, Seniors, Juniors, Masters, Cadets, Men and Women will be ranked together based on Qualification Score. All will shoot 70m) Cubs and Bowmen who can consistently hit 70m are welcome if the youth elimination round doesn't occur.
- **70m Compound** (All Compound, Seniors, Juniors, Masters, Cadets, Men and Women will be ranked together based on Qualification Score. All will shoot 70m) Cubs and Bowmen who can consistently hit 70m are welcome if the youth elimination round doesn't occur.
- **Depending on registration and interest, we may offer a Recurve Youth elimination round at a shorter distance:** (All Recurve and Barebow, Cubs and Bowmen, Men and Women will be ranked together based on Qualification Score.)
- **Depending on registration and interest, we may offer a Recurve Youth elimination round at a shorter distance:** (All Compound, Cubs and Bowmen, Men and Women will be ranked together based on their Qualification Score.)

**WHAT IS THE SET SYSTEM?**

**In Eliminations up to 1/4 finals**, the match comprises a maximum **3 sets of 6 arrows/set**. The winner of each set (i.e. who gets the highest score in the six arrows) gets two (2) set points, if the set is a tie each archer gets one (1) set point. The winner of the match is determined by the number of set points won, not the value of the arrows. **The match winner is the first to reach 4 set points**, and will finish once this target is reached within the three sets. If the match is still tied after 3 sets (i.e. 3 points each) then a one arrow (closest to the center) shoot-off will determine the match winner.

**For 1/4 finals onwards**, the match changes to a maximum **5 sets of three arrows/set**. **The match winner this time being the first to 6 points**, and again, if the match is ultimately tied (i.e. 5 points each), a one arrow (closest to the center) shoot-off will be used to break the tie.
