**LOCATION:** Ben Avery Shooting Facility, FITA Range, Phoenix, Arizona

TOURNAMENT RULES: USA ARCHERY including USAA dress code and new FITA rules effective April 1, 2011 will be enforced.

<u>CHAMPIONSHIP ELIGIBILITY:</u> USA Archery membership listing Arizona as your residence is required for you to compete for State Championship titles and awards. Guests (Non-USAA and/or Non-Arizonans) are welcome to shoot in a guest category.

<u>CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS:</u> Awards will be distributed for the Arizona State Outdoor Championship based on the number of actual participants in the category using the following awards structure:

• Up to 2 participants: 1<sup>st</sup> place only

3 - 4 participants: 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place only
 5 or more: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places
 JOAD categories: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> places

• Guest categories: no awards

#### QUALIFICATION ROUND: 144 arrow Qualification Round will determine the State Champions

- All Recurve Seniors and Recurve Juniors will shoot a four distance FITA. (90/70m, 70/60m, 50m, 30m)
- All Recurve Masters and Recurve Cadets will shoot a four distance FITA. (70/60m, 60/50m, 50/40m, 30m)
- All Recurve Cubs will shoot a four distance FITA. (50m, 40m, 30m, 20m)
- All Recurve Bowmen will shoot a four distance FITA. (30m, 25m, 25m, 20m)
- All Recurve long distances will be on a 122cm face and short distances on a 80cm-6 ring individual target face
- All Compound Seniors, Juniors, Masters, Cadets will shoot 144 arrows at 50m 80cm-6 ring individual target face
- All Compound Cubs will shoot 144 arrows at 30m 80cm-6 ring individual target face
- All Compound Bowman will shoot 144 arrows at 25m 80cm-6 ring individual target face
- All ends are 4 minute, 6 arrow ends.
- Guests are welcome to shoot in a Guest category.

**SHADE AND CHAIRS**: There will be shade for Archers and Spectators; however you should bring your own chairs. There is bleacher seating for Spectators.
