SUMMER SIZZLE FORMAT: Double FITA I - INDOOR 25/18 meter Tournament (Star FITA)

Recurve Bow and Barebow – 25 meter 600 round (60 arrows) - 60 cm target face and 18 meter 600 round (60 arrows) - 40 cm target face. (Choice of single-spot, triangle or vertical — must use choice for entire tournament); outer 10 ring scoring. (Double 600 round = 60 arrows x 2 rounds = 120 arrows)

Compound Bow - 25 meter 600 round (60 arrows) - 60 cm target face and 18 meter 600 round (60 arrows) - 40 cm target face. (Choice of single spot, triangle or vertical — must use choice for entire tournament); bowman and cub compounds use outer 10 ring scoring, Cadet and above use inner 10 ring scoring. (Double 600 round = 60 arrows x 2 rounds = 120 arrows) (60 Pound draw weight maximum as measured by the Tournament scale)

Target Face – 60 cm for 25 meter round, 40 cm 10 ring, triangle or vertical for 18 meter round. (Two archers will share 60cm face). The tournament reserves the right to provide the target faces type per target buttress allocation.

USAA rules apply. Equipment and Arrow size limitations per USAA Rules and Regulations.

FITA Indoor Arrow: "8.3.1.7.1 an arrow consists of a shaft with head (point) nock, fletching and, if desired, cresting. The maximum diameter of arrow shafts will not exceed 9.3mm; the heads (points) for these arrows may have a maximum diameter of 9.4mm. All arrows of every athlete must be marked with the athlete's name or initials on the shaft, and all arrows used at any end will carry the same pattern and colour(s) of fletching, nocks and cresting, if any".

USAA Dress Code will be enforced...this includes official practice sessions <u>See USA Archery - Rules & Regulations - Dress Code</u>

Compound bow limit is 60 lbs.

ADULT CLASSES:

"Senior", (any age) "Masters 50+", (Born in or before 1962) "Masters 60+", (Born in or before 1952) "Masters 70+"(Born in or before 1942)

YOUTH CLASSES:

"Junior" through the calendar year of their 20th birthday (Born in or after 1992). "Cadet" through the calendar year of their 17th birthday (Born in or after 1995). "Cub" through the calendar year of their 14th birthday (Born in or after 1998). "Bowman" through the calendar year of their 12th birthday (Born in or after 2000).

AWARDS: Each category to receive awards based on total of both rounds.
