The 2012 FITA Field State Championship was held at Usery Mountain Regional Park on October 20 and 21. Over thirty archers competed in the two day contest with many challenging shots on rugged terrain. The first day of competition tested the archer's accuracy for shooting uphill, downhill, across dry deep desert washes at targets from unknown distances between 5 meters to 50 meters.

The second day of competition the distances are marked but are longer. Targets only 20 centimeters wide that were hard enough at 5 meters were moved out to 15 meters. The archers had a sunny day on Saturday with temperatures rising throughout the morning of competition. Sunday was sunny, however, strong winds blew in and all archers had to adjust and "play the wind." The JOAD age archers competed with adults at the same targets, under the same conditions, and only slightly closer.
